Sample answers:

1. Yes, I have. [I was on TV in 2005. I was on a game show.] / No, I haven't.
2. Yes, we / they have. We / They moved [from Mexico City to Austin, Texas, in 2010]. / No, we / they haven't. [We've / They've always lived in Mexico City.]
3. Yes, I have. I went skydiving / No, I haven't [but I'm going skydiving for my 21st birthday next year].
4. Yes, I have. [I liked it a lot. / I hated it! I was really scared.] / No, I haven't.

B Student A's own answers

Sample answers:

1. Yes, I have. I met [Brad Pitt at a hotel in Las Vegas]. / No, I haven't.
2. Yes, she / he has. It was for [a photograph]. / No, she / he hasn't.
3. Yes, I have. I've climbed [Mount Kilimanjaro]. / No, I haven't.
4. Yes, I have. I've eaten [octopus]. [I loved it.] / No, I haven't.

C Student B's questions

1. Has Marty ever acted in a play?
2. Was Marty on TV in 2008?
3. Have Marty's friends ever seen him on TV? When?
4. Did they think it was amusing? Why? What happened?

Student A's answers

Sample answers:

1. No, he hasn't.
2. No, he wasn't (but his painting and name were on TV).
3. Yes, some of them have. They saw him on the ten o'clock news last month.
4. Yes, they did. They thought it was amusing because Marty ran into an actor and a TV reporter.

D Student A's questions

1. Did Steve see Marty on TV last month?
2. Has Steve ever had an embarrassing moment? What happened?
3. Where did he find his things?
4. Was his wife upset? Why?

Student B's answers

Sample answers:

1. No, he didn't.
2. Yes, he has. He "lost" his wallet, keys, and cell phone (and was late for a job interview).

4. Yes, she was. She was upset because he was late for a job interview, and he didn't get the job.
