4. Yes, I can. / Sure. (Where are you going?) / No, I can't. [I don't have my car today.]

B Student A's own answers*Sample answers:*

1. I'm [playing basketball with friends and having dinner with my parents] on Sunday.
2. Yes, I am. (It's at 4:15.) / No, I'm not.
3. Yes, I do. (It's on Monday.) / No, I don't.
4. No problem. (Which subject do you need help with?) / Sorry. [I'm busy tonight.]

1. Does Joe have a violin lesson on Friday?
